### **MRI Orientation and Training Program**

To ensure a safe and knowledgeable working environment, all potential MR operators must complete formal training as outlined below. Upon satisfactory completion of this orientation program, only those deemed "Qualified Operators" by the MR Steering Committee will be assigned a one year safety certificate.

Each researcher and staff will complete an orientation in the MR facility via a walk through, demonstration of the equipment, and safety procedures. All orientation sessions will be supervised and documented.

Orientation/Training will include:

#### **Nursing Procedures**

1. Screening/Safety
2. Consent Forms
3. Monitoring Equipment
4. Emergencies
5. Code Procedures

#### **Scanning Procedures**

1. Coil Selection/Set up
2. Positioning
3. Pulse Sequence Selection
4. Imaging Options Selection
5. Scanner Startup/Shutdown
6. Record Keeping/Documentation
7. Archiving/Deletion of Data

#### **Startup/Shutdown Procedures**

1. Processor Startup/Shutdown
2. Laser Camera Startup/Shutdown
